From Tulsa:

Take OK-351/Muskogee Turnpike south, travel 42 miles to exit US Highway 62 to Tahlequah, continue East 24 miles on Highway 62 to D0790 Rd/E Willis Rd turn right, then turn left onto S Seven Clans Ave.

From Oklahoma City:

Take Interstate 40 East from OKC to OK-351/Muskogee Turnpike North exit. Travel 142 miles to exit US Highway 62 East to Tahlequah. Continue East 21.7 miles to D0790 Rd/E Willis Rd turn right then turn left onto S Seven Clans Ave.

72nd Cherokee National Holiday Quilt Show Rules

1. Entry forms must be completed and received by August 23, 2024.
2. Cherokee National Quilt Show reserves the right to refuse and assumes no liability for entries that require special handling.
3. All entries must be 100% completed, clean and free of any pet hair, odor, or smoke and in good condition.
4. A label with entrant's name, address, phone number and name of quilt should be pinned to the lower right back corner of each quilt.
5. Cherokee Nation reserves the right to move entries to correct categories as deemed by the Quilt Show Committee.
6. All entries must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show and will not be released until all quilts have been dismantled.
7. Three entries are allowed per category but need to be numbered 1-3 in case there is not enough space to hang all three entries. **One entry form per item must be filled out.**
8. Items previously entered in a Cherokee National Holiday Show will not be accepted.
9. No tacked quilts.
10. No food, drink nor smoking will be allowed in the exhibit area.
11. **All items entered must have been made in the last five years, July 2019 through July 2024.**

72nd Cherokee National Holiday Themed Entry Rules

1. Entry forms must be completed and received by August 23, 2024.
2. All Wall Hanging entries must reflect/pertain to this year's Holiday theme: "Weaving Our Future".
3. Wall Hanging size not to exceed a 30x42 in size. No size exceptions will be made; Quilt Show Coordinator reserves the right to enter it into the proper/correct category.
4. No tacked wall hangings will be accepted.
5. Wall Hangings previously entered in a Cherokee National Holiday Show will not be accepted.
6. Cherokee Nation Quilt Show reserves the right to refuse Wall Hanging entries and or assumes no liability for entries that require special handling.
7. All Wall Hanging entries must be 100% completed, clean and free of any pet hair, odor or smoke and in good condition.
8. A label with entrant's name, address, phone number, and name of entry should be pinned to the lower right back corner of each Wall Hanging.
9. All Wall hanging entries must remain on exhibit for the duration of the quilt show and will not be released until all quilts have been dismantled.
